

MILTON BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING
October 22, 2014

The meeting was called to order with the following Councilpersons in attendance: Mr. Keiser, Mr. Specht, Mrs. Meckley, Mr. Cyphers, Mr. Budman, Mr. Farr, Mr. Shearer, Mr. Jones, Mr. Swartz, and Mr. Walker. Also in attendance were Mr. Beck, Mayor Nelson, Mr. Benion, Sam Shaffer, Chief Zettlemyer, Officer Engleman, and Shelly Sandstrom. Attorney Benion was absent.

Minutes: On motion of Mr. Cyphers, seconded by Mr. Walker and carried, Council approved the minutes from the October 8, 2014 Council meeting. Mr. Farr, Mr. Shearer, and Mr. Budman abstained.

Report of the Borough Manager: Mr. Beck had no report.

Report of the Mayor: Mayor Nelson reminded everyone that Trick or Treating in the Borough would be on October 31, 2014 from 6:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.

Report of the President of Council: President Budman had no report.

Report of the Chief of Police: Chief Zettlemyer reported that the department created a Public Service Announcement video regarding safety at Halloween. The video was shown to the school students. Chief also reported that there have been several residential burglaries recently and that the PD has some good leads on them.

Report of the Fire Chief: Sam Shaffer reported that the Department has finished all of the fire protection safety. They have had six calls in less than one week. Mr. Shaffer also reported that the Fire Department would be giving out candy and glow necklaces on Halloween.

Public Comments: There were no public comments.

Highways and Protection to Persons and Property: No report.

General Government and Recreation

- A. On motion of Mrs. Meckley, seconded by Mr. Specht and carried, Council approved the revised Corrective Action Plan from DCED.
- B. On motion of Mrs. Meckley, seconded by Mr. Specht and carried, Council rescinded Resolution 14-08.
- C. On motion of Mrs. Meckley, seconded by Mr. Farr and carried, Council approved a storm water right-of-way in the fifth ward on Susquehanna Avenue between Shakespeare and Turbot. The costs given by Mr. Beck were \$3,000 for the right-of-way and approximately \$2,000 for survey costs. This project will begin in the Spring of 2015.
- D. On motion of Mr. Specht, seconded by Mr. Farr and carried, Council authorized Mr. Beck to write a letter allowing Lisa's Milltown Deli and Milltown Steak and Seafood to serve

alcoholic beverages in the exterior of the property located at the southeast corner of Broadway and Bound Avenue. Mrs. Meckley was opposed.

Finance, Health and Sanitation

- A. On motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Cyphers and carried, Council approved paying the bills from General Fund, Reserve, Payroll, Community Pool and Cemetery accounts in the amount of \$94,824.33.

President Budman announced that Council would be entering into an Executive Session regarding personnel issues in the Police Department and that Council would not reconvene.

There being no further business, on motion of Mr. Cyphers, seconded by Mr. Shearer, Council adjourned at 7:21 p.m.
